
CATALYSTS FOR CHANGE: OUR 2016 TOP ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND COMMUNITY IMPACT

More than **2.4 million** SisterPact impressions were made at **180** events in **25** Mid-South ZIP codes.




More than **50%** of participants in the 4th Annual Million Calorie Burn were **under 17** years old.




3rd Annual LIVE Memphis Breast Cancer Summit attracted more than 700 breast cancer survivors and advocates.
